1. SFS Analyst – 15511BR
 - The SFS Analyst will be the point person for driving our aggressive business goals...

2. Compliance Analyst – 15839BR

Compliance Analyst will be responsible for ensuring the regulatory requirements are met for all international shipments for the CDIY division along with identifying and implementing process improvement opportunities for export processes.
3. Call Center Technical Manager – 15866BR
 - The Call Center Technical Manager plays a key role in developing processes, and supporting the service organizations within the Stanley Black & Decker Contact Center(s.) This role supports the initiation, development, and execution of assigned projects within a defined period of time, and will work closely with the functional business groups to ensure the efficiency and effectiveness of solutions deployed in support of business goals and objectives.
4. Quality Analyst – 15876BR
 - The Call Center Quality Analyst plays a key role in monitoring all aspects of quality in our End User Service Team. This includes monitoring case and phone activity to ensure compliance with standard operational procedures, departmental metrics and customer satisfaction objectives.
5. S&OP Process Analyst – 15866BR
 - The Sales & Operations Planning Analyst will develop and run analytics to drive internal and external KPIs (Key Performance Indicators), inventory reduction (GMROI), improve working capital and develop best practices. Proven experience in Supply Chain and Strategic Planning Optimization with an emphasis in S&OP is required.
6. Inventory Planner – 15891BR
 - The Inventory Planner will be a key member of the Supply Planning Team with the primary responsibility being to provide superior service level of supplied products, while maintaining appropriate control of inventory and cost. The Inventory Planner will be responsible for production planning SBDK facility, serving the planning objectives of the U.S. markets as well as the needs of EMEA, Canada, Latin America, Asia, and Australia. The Supply Planner will be a good steward of the Plant assets of tooling, people, and WIP by buffering them from market variation and appropriate use of "extreme change".

8. S&OP Manager – 15996BR

- The S & OP Manager will work on continuous process improvements with the demand planning and S&OP areas. This person will be the owner of a cutting edge software module within the JDA software suite. As owner of this new tool you will be responsible for developing the right promotion planning processes, analytics and implementations across the CDIY business. This person will also play a major role in supporting our roll-outs of our Global Demand Planning system (JDA) globally. There are additional opportunities to be part of the core team that will be developing the design and implementing a Global Supply Planning solution.

9. Supply Chain Manager – 15970BR

- The Supply Chain Leader will develop and run analytics to drive inventory reduction, improve working capital and inventory turns, maintain vendor managed inventory and develop best practices for global supply planning. This position is for someone interested in global supply management, LEAN manufacturing and operational excellence.
